WHY A MISSION ON CLIMATE-NEUTRAL CITIES?

- **75%** of EU citizens live in cities (projected to increase to about 85% in 2050)
- More than 65% of energy consumption and more than 70% of CO2 emissions worldwide
- Rooted in R&I and delivering concrete results within a limited timeframe
- Co-benefits lower air/noise pollution, congestion and fewer road deaths. Loveable and livable cities!
- The European Green Deal is set at EU / national level, but will be implemented at local level – particularly in cities and regions: where policy meets people!
- Cities have the ambition to go further we want to help cities achieve their goal of climate neutrality by 2030





OBJECTIVES OF THE MISSION

1

Deliver at least 100 climate-neutral and smart European cities by 2030;

2

Ensure that these cities act as experimentation and innovation hubs to put all European cities in a position to become climate-neutral by 2050.





CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

- 377 cities from all EU member states and 9 associated countries submitted expressions of interest
- Evaluation process supported by independent experts, determining
 - cities' level of ambition and preparedness
 - cities' commitment to involving citizens and stakeholders
- Based on the assessment, the Commission will select the participating cities, representing
 - true geographic diversity and inclusiveness
 - range among cities, regions, urban characteristics and sizes
- Selected cities will be announced in spring 2022

Horizon Europe


Mission platform

- Run by the NetZeroCities consortium
- Tailor-made technical, regulatory and financial advice
- R&I demonstrators
- Twinning and mutual learning

Portfolio of R&I projects

Climate City Contracts

- Including climate action plan and investment strategy
- Innovative city governance and citizen engagement
- Involvement of European, national and regional level



- Synergies with other programmes
- Help with access to funding and financing





CLIMATE CITY CONTRACTS

- **Tailor-made plans** on how to reach climate neutrality, adapted to the individual needs of the city, supported by the Mission Platform
- Non legally binding Memorandum of Understanding
- To be **co-created in spirit of multi-level governance**, with the involvement of national authorities, regions and local stakeholders, including citizens and local economic actors
- Focus on innovative ("holistic") city governance, investment plan, and monitoring and reporting
- Signed by the Mayor (or equivalent), witnessed by the Commission and others
- Unlocks Mission label





FUNDING AND FINANCING

- Individual city investment plan to be developed with help of the Mission Platform as part of CCC
- Support expected from different EU funding programmes
- Cooperation with the European Investment Bank Group and national Promotional Institutions (e.g. financial advisory, possibly Blending Facility)
- Private investors (individuals, private companies, commercial banks)
- EU sustainable finance agenda offers new opportunities to encourage investors to invest locally





R&I CONTENT

- Goals: develop capacity and showcase possibilities of scale-up and replicability
- Portfolio of R&I activities targeting cities and communities in the Horizon Europe Work
 Programme for Missions
- Complementarity and synergy with ongoing and upcoming initiatives, e.g. partnerships
- **R&I pilot projects** supported by the Mission Platform through open calls for proposals (to be launched after summer 2022) addressed to cities.





SYNERGIES WITH OTHER PROGRAMMES FOR CITIES

- The Mission will not replace involvement in other programmes, such as the Covenant of Mayors or Climate Pact, but build synergies with them
- The Mission aims to build synergies with existing programmes to add value on both sides, without creating unnecessary additional work for cities.
- All relevant initiatives in which cities are participating and relevant to the Mission's objective are taken into account as they contribute to achieving its successful implementation (e.g. Circular Cities Declaration)
- A Mission label will help create funding opportunities in EU & other programmes
- National networks will ensure synergies with national and regional programmes
